Sunday the 8th of August

Those who want to stay and gather on Saturday afternoon are welcome to stay on Lindegaard, enjoying and celebrating the summer. The camping ground stays open until Sunday, so you do not have to leave right after the round table on Saturday.

“What is my status in the knighthood?”

The 5 year rule applies on both Squires and Knights. This means, that you have 5 years, from your last test, to update your Squire test: (Groundwork-lunge test and Squire test) to keep your status. This also applies for Knights. If a Knight can't show the Knight level or update a ring test, when it's time to update, but instead can show a Squire test, he or she will then be a Squire.

If your Knight or Squire test already is older than 5 years, and you haven't updated the test before this year's Summer Academy, you will then become a member of the Knighthood (without voting right), and no longer a Squire or a Knight.

Squires that are up to date will from the year they have signed themselves in to the Book of the Knighthood have the same rights as a Knight. This means that a Squire will write his or her name in to the Book of the Knighthood and as well get a number and the Silver knob for the whip. An updated Squire may vote at the Round Table and have the possibility to get at link with name and contact info on the homepage of the Knighthood. Remember to bring your Silver Knob to the roundtable.

IMPORTANT: If you are updating you Squire status you have to remember your receipt from the test, if you wish to write your name into the Book of the Knighthood. If you are a new squire or you update/upgrade to squire status (especially if you don't have the whip decoration yet), please bring both the receipts for the groundwork-/longe-test and the squire-test

Prices:

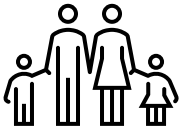
Squire **upgrade** for “old” members (if you don't have the whip decoration yet): 100 Euro. New Squire: 400 Euro. New Knight (if you already have the whip decoration): 200 Euro. It does not cost anything when you update, a longe-/groundwork-, squire or knight test. Also the update of the new squire level (if you already have the whip decoration) is free.

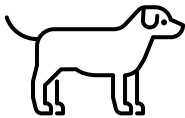

Practical information:



- Your **family** is welcome for camping and barbeque but you may not bring adult family members or friends to join the program, public morning work on Thursday is a exemption this year.



- Please, do not bring your **dog** unless you have to. We want to avoid any conflict between dogs, dogs and other animals or children and dogs at our place. If you bring a dog, it must be safe with other dogs and children and it is not allowed to run around unattended.

Danish law about dogs is very strict, if the police gets notice about a dog or human who was injured by another dog (for example from a vet or a doctor), the dog causing the injury is taken by the police to be euthanized. **NO MATTER WHAT THE CIRCUMSTANCES WERE!** Be aware of this, also when you are on holiday with your dog in Denmark.

How to register for Summer Academy 2021

By taking the registration that late we would like to avoid refunds.**

Your contact details on the homepage of the Knighthood

Every knight and squire has the right to be named with his/her picture and their status on the homepage. This is for free, but we need your consent to be allowed to make your information public. In addition every knight, squire and master can have their contact details (homepage, adress, telephone number) next to his/her name and picture. This service costs 20 € per year which are used for keeping the homepage online and up to date. **You can only book this service once a year during the**

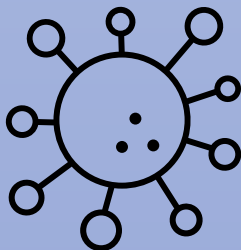
application period for Summer Academy in the online shop. You can also book this if you can't join Summer Academy this year.

COVID-19 precautions

When you come to the Summer Academy, please bring a valid "Corona-passport". That means:



- documentation of full vaccination (2. shot 14 days ago at least)
- OR documentation of a previous infection
- OR a negative antigen test (max. 72 old)
- OR a negative PCR test (max. 96 h old)
- This is the same documentation you need to enter Denmark (just that the tests need to be more fresh, when crossing the border). If your corona test is not valid anymore, you can take a new one for free in Nykøbing.

We will control the documentation during Summer Academy!

There are two places where ventilation might not be optimal during Summer Academy: The buffet and the riding arena (depending on the number of participants). When going to the buffet, please use a mask and disinfect your hands. We will have masks and disinfection available. If you prefer to use a mask in the riding arena, please bring your own FFP2 mask, because that is the quality that can protect YOU from others. Masks will NOT be mandatory in the riding arena or outdoors.

For reasons of hygiene the coffee shop will not offer the same services as it used to. In order to keep things clean and simple: please bring or organize your lunch, we will not have sandwiches for sale.

We will offer hot water for tea and coffee and cold beverages (bottled). You are more than welcome to bring your own mug, so we don't have to wash dishes.

Especially indoors, keeping distance is still recommended, feel free to ask for more distance if that makes you feel more comfortable and please respect if others ask you to keep more distance without discussing it. We will have badges available to remind others about keeping distance. We are aware that the status of restrictions and vaccinations is very different in the countries of our guests, so the current "normal" is very different for all of us.

You would love to hug? Please make sure those you want to hug are ready for it ;-)
